

## Lesson #3 Jigsaw Cooperative Learning Activity

### Expert Group Instructions

In your group, you will work with a team member(s) to learn more about your assigned topic (critical attribute) using the video and transcript provided. Then you will prepare materials that you will use to teach the members of your Home Group about what you've learned. You are expected to create the same materials and each share them with your own Home Groups.

As you work in your "Expert" group to design your teaching materials, the most important thing you will want to do is teach your Home Group to remember the NAME of your critical attribute, a DEFINITION (what this attribute means), and an EXAMPLE of the critical attribute. These will be assessed at the end of the lesson.

Also consider the following:

- ◆ What "stands out" or appears to you as being most important to remember from your critical attribute?
- ◆ How will you make this memorable to your Home Group? What creative or memory-enhancing methods do you know that you could put to work to help your Home Group? (graphics, visualization, analogies, storytelling, examples, limerick, song, mnemonic device, etc.)
- ◆ What do members of your Home Group already know related to the topic you will be presenting? Is there a way to identify this and build on it?
- ◆ Are there any possible misunderstandings that the members of your Home Group will have and need pointed out and dispelled?
- ◆ Is there anything that you think members of your Home Group will find confusing or need clarified?
